Save the Date! **Pancake Party** on Tuesday 5th March in the community centre.

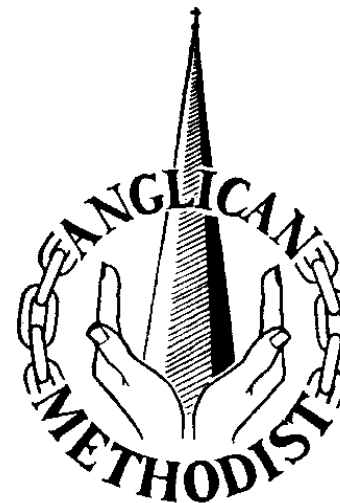


Sermon practice following Hannah's sermon 10/2/19

Application/questions for individual and group discussion (based on Isaiah 6:1-8, Luke 5:1-11)
