Custard (tinned), Tomatoes, Vegetables, Potatoes (tinned), Cereal or Oats,
Dried Pasta, Rice or Instant Noodles, Baked Beans or Kidney Beans,
Tinned Mead or Tinned Fish, Biscuits or Snack Bars, Jams, Marmalades
or Spreads, Tinned Fruit, Shower Gel, Shampoo, Shaving Foam,
