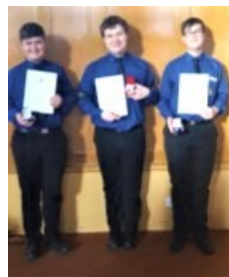
### Passover Meal
