I overheard a conversation between two people as one said to the other, "Get A Life". I am not sure if it was said in jest or disdain! But, it set me thinking, what kind of a life was being recommended.

A theologian said, "Life can be purely existing or life can be in abundance".

Watching the news, reading the papers and social media 'life' may be seen in a so many different ways:-

Some positive, (Abundant) some negative, (Existing) and all points in-between.

In John's Gospel **life** is one of the important themes running throughout it's pages. Right at the beginning we are told (John 1:4), 4 **In him was life**, and that life was the light of all mankind (People)',

This light of life which drives away the darkness of our world is the source of our spiritual renewal.

The great statement of Jesus in John 10:10b, "I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly". leads me to ask how do we see abundant life.?

Abundance according to the dictionary means, 'present in great quantity', 'over-sufficient', or 'richly supplied with resources'.

But we need to pause to think what the Bible teaches us about Abundant life.

The Bible tells us that wealth, prestige, position, and power in this world are not God's priorities for us. (1 Corinthians 1:26-29). In John 17:3 (NIV) Jesus says, 3 "Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent".

Eternal life starts as we begin our relationship with Jesus and continues as we grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus our Saviour. (2Pet 3v18) It will continue as we meet Jesus in heaven.

As any gardener will say, growth takes time, and this is achieved in us as we follow Jesus and allow the Holy Spirit to lead us, progressing through stages of learning, practicing, maturing, failing, recovering, trusting, adjusting, enduring and overcoming the events of this life.

Abundant life is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, self-control, the fruit of the Spirit, with the gifts of the Holy Spirit to help us in this life. It's the life Jesus came to show us.
